Segway UT10 Crew 4-Door Models



We highly recommend the installation of this stereo top to be performed by an authorized AudioFormz dealer. Warranty of stereo top and/or components may be voided if not installed correctly.


Step 1 Remove the existing roof


A) Using the predrilled holes, install the REAR light bar on the new roof first.

B) <u>Models with rear window:</u> Remove the factory bolts, spacers and nuts from the <u>rear</u> window, and remove the window. **(© 1B ►)**

C) Remove the existing roof.

D) Remove the rear corner cage braces from the roll cage on each side. $\fbox{1}$





Step 2 Set the new roof on roll cage

A) Set the top on the roll cage and line it up.

B) **IMPORTANT:** PUSH THE ROOF ALL THE WAY FORWARD, making sure the roof is even on both sides in the rear.



We recommend 2+ people to help install **Roofs require team lift!**


IMPORTANT: If roof does not sit properly, check roll cage for squareness. All 4 corners should have equal measurements. Loosen upper cage bolts to adjust if necessary. Contact AudioFormz for further assistance.



Step 3 Secure the front of the roof

B) Place the "C" bracket between the front corner tab on the roll cage and pre-drilled mounting holes at the top of the roof. Place a ¼"-20 x 2½" bolt with a large fender washer through the roof, the "C" bracket, and the factory mounting hole on the front corner tab of the roll cage as shown.

C) Hand tighten the nylon lock nut with the 1" flat washer from underneath.






Step 4 Secure the rear part of the roof

A) There is a tab at the back of the roll cage with a mounting hole. Using this as a guide, make a pilot hole from the bottom with a small drill bit first. Then with a 1/4" bit, drill out the pilot hole as shown.

B) Place a $\frac{1}{4}$ "-20 x 2" bolt with a large fender washer through the top of the roof. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ "-20 nylon locking nut and a 1" flat washer from underneath to secure the back of the roof.

C) Tighten all bolts and nuts from the previous steps.








Step 5 Connect roof to power

A) Run the wire down the roll cage to the battery. <u>Fuse holder must be properly installed</u> within 18" of the battery. Connect to the battery on the passenger side. Image 5A→
